

BLOUNT COUNTY YOUTH FOOTBALL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All children that participate in the Blount County Youth Football Program will abide by the following rules or forfeit all rights to any and all rewards given during the season.

1. The child shall attend all games, including the jamboree, play-offs and regular season games.
2. In the event your child cannot attend a game, the coach or sponsor must be notified at least two (2) hours before the game time.
3. If your child misses more than two (2) games without notice from a parent/guardian, he/she will be considered quit and will not receive a trophy at the end of the season.
4. No refunds will be given if your child resigns after the jamboree, nor will he/she receive a trophy.
5. All fees must be paid before the fitting and before the child receives any equipment. These include, but are not limited to: registration fees, jerseys and uniforms. This money goes toward insurance, use of the football field, purchase of equipment, trophies, etc.
6. There will be **NO REFUNDS**.
7. Each child is expected to perform at every practice and game, regardless of weather. The referees will call any games off if the weather is not suitable for play. Rain or cold weather is not one of these reasons. If there is a scheduled game or practice, all children are expected to be there. The coach or sponsor will notify the coach or the sponsor before leaving.
8. Parents will be responsible for purchasing, at regular purchasing, any equipment that is lost, stolen or damaged (beyond regular wear and tear).
9. There will be a date set at the end of the season to turn in equipment. Parents will be billed for replacement of equipment if not returned.
10. Alcohol or drugs are strictly prohibited on any property owned by the Oneonta City Board of Education and the Oneonta Park and Recreation Department. This includes all practice fields, stadium and school campus. If you violate these rules, proper authorities will be notified.
